The entire Hotel was recently extensively renovated, keeping its special style while ensuring the highest levels of quality and service.



You literally ski out the door to the Akakura Onsen Ski Area; with more than 13 meters of snow annually, you're guaranteed great skiing at this diverse ski area. Enjoy a four-kilometer run from the 1,500-meter-plus top of the hill, or whatever else fits your skills and interests: powder skiing, bumps, terrain parks, or just fun family cruising.

It's a resort for all seasons: Skiing from late December to mid/end April; golfing at the Hotel's 18-hole course in spring, summer and fall; hiking; sightseeing in the area or in nearby Nagano city; wildlife watching; biking; mountain climbing—there's always something to do at the Akakura Kanko Hotel.
